First, on behalf of my wife and business partner, Chelle, I want to express our gratitude for your confidence expressed in our technology by purchasing our product.

It has become crystal clear to us over the past few months there is a major void in education for our end users in properly preparing Acculength golf clubs for play. Thus, we EMPHASIZE the following guidelines as a part of properly prepping our golf clubs prior to play:

Very Important -

- 1. Remove clubs from box - REMOVE set pins from clubs completely. The pins are "soft set" from the factory and are not designed to be pulled out of the bag and played prior to some minor prep as I am describing here.**
- 2. Holding the club head and grip, (assuming Right handed clubs) rotate the club clockwise to loosen and partially unscrew the grip handle portion of the club.**
- 3. Rotate counter clockwise now and "hand torque" the base club component to the grip handle to ensure a tight, metal to metal compression between the two club components.**
- 4. Re-install the set pin - hand torque tightness to ensure a secure compression into the spacer locking channel.**

Now the clubs are ready for play. In almost every instance, having 50,000 plus clubs currently in use throughout the world, following these steps will prevent any type of defective issues going forward.
